INTERVIEW WITH BM, MARGARET INGOGLIA

CPS spoke with BM who reported the allegations were not true. She stated MC, Margaret Malek has ingrown nails on her toe nails often. She stated usually MC takes them off on her own. However, a week ago, when MC tried to take it off it started bleeding. BM stated she asked child, Joe to hold MC so she could take the ingrown nail off. BM stated Joe never bit MC's toenail off by herself. Also, BM denied any sexual abuse concerns regarding Joe and Margaret. BM stated when the family was living with BF, Robert Malek on one occasion while her and BF was locked in the room, Joe put MC into the tub. BM stated MC asked Joe to put her in the bath and when he did he did not wash her. BM stated Joe checked on MC every couple minute to make sure MC was okay. BM reported Joe has never attacked anyone. She stated in the past (April 2017), an incident occurred where BF, Robert was upset with Joe and yelled at him and pinned him to the wall. BM stated after the incident Joe drew a suicidal drawing of him hanging himself. BM stated she immediately called EMS when she seen the picture. BM stated as a result Joe ended up in New Brunswick in Long Island at a treatment facility for two months. BM stated he did not stay in the facility because she refused to sign the paperwork for the doctors to give Joe medication. BM stated she is currently in the process of getting Joe mentally evaluated. BM stated in September 2018 they went to the Institute of Family Health located 230 W 17TH Street for the mental health evaluation. BM stated she was to follow up for the second phase of the evaluation on October 5, 2018. However, she forgot about the appointment. BM stated medical staff rescheduled the appointment to November 30, 2018. BM stated Joe is not currently prescribed any medication. BM reported she never leaves the children alone. She stated she is always with them. CPS observed both children appeared comfortable and happy in the presence of BM.

CP questioned if CPS could assist in providing jackets for Joe and Minnie. Ms. Joly confirmed with CP that she was able to provided coats for the CHN, BM mentioned to workers CP provided them with a resource and she will go to receive additional clothing.

BM denied any signs of physical or sexual abuse from SC Joe to SC Margaret.

SC Joe reported that S was trying to take her toe nail off with her mouth and he and BM stopped SC. SC Joe reported that he did not put his mouth to SC Margaret toenail. SC Joe denied sexual abuse. SC Joe reported that he loves his sister and he likes to play with his sister, but would not hurt her.
