





I'm sure he wasn't too happy about that, but he served his time, then launched a career as a chemist. He soon found that lab work wasn't his thing, so he pursued a more fulfilling career in Urban Development with the Urban League of Greater New Brunswick, where he worked for 57 years. Whoa! Roy had found his calling.




