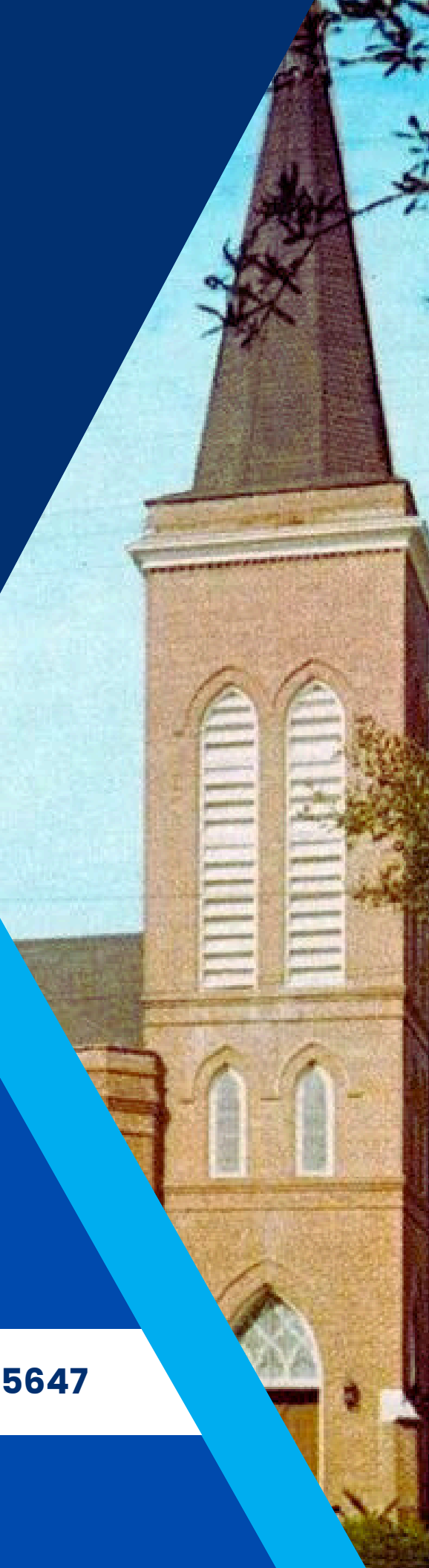

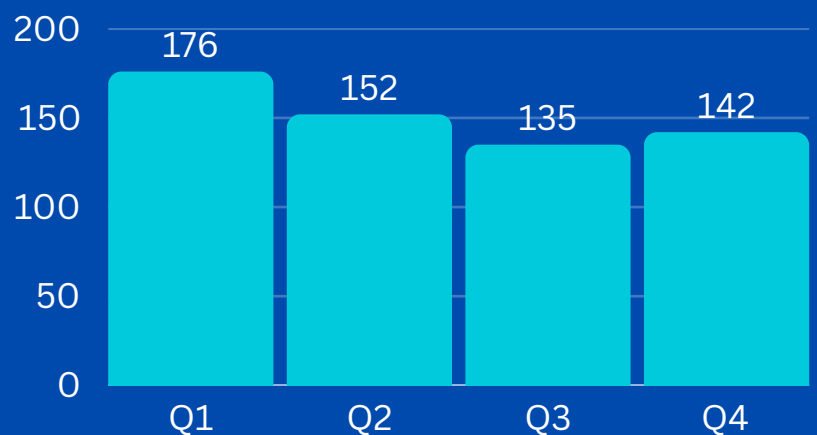

Our local mission work includes supporting "Students in the Word," a program allowing students to study the Bible off-campus for class credit, Helping Hands of Georgetown, Good Friends of Georgetown County, Friendship Place, Salvation Army, and Habitat for Humanity. Church members actively volunteer and serve on boards for these organizations, demonstrating our commitment to this community through both financial support and hands-on involvement.



Nationally, we collected supplies to donate to Western North Carolina after Hurricane Helene. Through partnering with others in the Georgetown community, our support included filling a U-Haul with books to restock the library at Old Fort Elementary School.



We also support two international Missionaries, one in Japan and another in Honduras. These missionaries are connected to members of Duncan and through our communications, we gain valuable insights into the global impact of our shared faith.
