Revelation 11:15-19

Intro:

Reflecting on the Word: What is connected to the sounding of the 7th trumpet?

1. The Announcement (11:15)

15 Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become (*to undergo a change or development*) the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.”---**Revelation 10:7; 12:10; 16:17; 19:1; Psalm 2:2; Acts 4:26; Exodus 15:18; Daniel 2:44; 7:14; Luke 1:33**

2. The Adoration (11:16-17)

16 And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,---**Matthew 19:28; Revelation 4:4**

17 saying, “We give You thanks, O Lord God, the Almighty, who are and who were, because You have taken Your great power and have begun to reign.---**Revelation 19:6**

3. The Activity (11:18-19)

18 “And the nations were enraged, and Your wrath came, and the time came for the dead to be judged, and the time to reward Your bond-servants the prophets and the saints and those who fear Your name, the small and the great, and to destroy those who destroy the earth.” ---**Psalm 2:1, 5:110:5; Daniel 7:10; Revelation 20:12; Psalm 115:13; Revelation 19:5**

19 And the temple of God which is in heaven was opened; and the ark of His covenant appeared in His temple, and there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder and an earthquake and a great hailstorm.--**Revelation 15:5; 4:5; 8:5; 16:8, 21**
