- Registration is permitted on the day of the tournament,
- **1** person from each team must check in in the morning for Take Off Order.
- Safe boating must be observed at all times.
- All boats must be equipped with emergency shutoff.
- **Life jackets will be worn when big motor is running**
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages or any kind of mind-altering drug during tournament hours is prohibited.
- All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship.
- All bass must be caught alive in a conventional manner. All bass caught while sight-fishing **must be hooked inside the mouth.**
- Only artificial lures may be used, with the exception of pork trailers.
- Teams who are not at the official weigh-in site at the appointed time will be **penalized 1 pound per minute** deducted from the total weight, including any weight counted toward big bass award.
- Every effort must be made to keep bass alive through the use of a properly aerated live well. Additives that promote the healthy return of the bass to their natural habitat are permitted.
- **A ¼ (quarter) pound penalty will be deducted from total weight for each dead fish. Dead fish may not be culled!**
- The pounds and ounces of each contestant's bass caught during the tournament will determine scoring. There is a 15" minimum length limit for both Largemouth and Smallmouth (mouth closed). **A short fish will result in a 1-pound penalty and loss of the short fish.**
- Only **5** fish maybe kept in the live well for weigh-in. **Any fish over will disqualify the team.**
- All boaters are required to have liability insurance.
- **Blast off spot determined by receipt of paid entries.**

****Any disputes will be settled by the tournament director at the Weigh-In.**

****Nebraska B.A.S.S. Nation is not liable for any accidents that occur during this tournament.**
