II. OUR APPEAL FOR MAJOR NEEDS

a) Among the local churches recently established, two face a challenge of plots (land) which to construct permanent sanctuary. Currently we hired small halls so they can continue with the conduct of worship services.

However, in Zanzibar Island – occupied mostly by Muslims, a plot is available for sale to the church at a rather high rate of \$4000. At Mkurambati (Tanzania Mainland), a plot is also available for \$3000

b) Purchase of 15 Tailoring Machines

We need to purchase the machines for use in the training. The price of each is \$ 120. The total is \$ 1,860 Training materials also needed to be purchased for \$1,000
