## **Preliminary Report Information**

What is the FEC Preliminary Report?

As part of our service to our potential clients, we take a look into their community to see if we can assist in improving the Public Protection Classification.

Here is how we do this...

We gather your information on the preliminary report information form and establish a primary point of contact, (usually the Fire Chief). We make contact and gather the following information....

- > A copy of your last ISO survey and the results of that survey.
- The current operational status of the Fire Department, Water Department and the Emergency Communications Center.
- ➤ Gather information on Community Risk Reduction, (these are multiple area fire prevention measures).
- > Information of any change in operation of all above mentioned areas.

Once this information is gathered, we analyze the data and will normally correspond several times with the Fire Chief and/or designees in order to get an accurate comparison of current operation - vs- when ISO last performed the survey.

Based on the information from the analysis, FEC will make a determination if we are able to assist your community in improving your Public Protection Classification. At that time FEC will create the Preliminary Report which will outline a breakdown of how your community scored on the last survey, A plan of action from FEC if you choose our services, and the cost of our services which will be based on the size and complexity of your community, the amount of work which needs to be done in your community and the distance and amount of needed travel to your community.
