01. For Individual Students

- “I really like how you started straight away, thank you.”
- “Great focus on that task, well done.”
- “Thank you for listening carefully.”
- “I can see you’re trying hard – keep it up.”
- “Excellent use of the vocabulary we practiced.”

02. For Groups or Pairs

- “Well done, this group is working quietly together.”
- “I can see lots of focus over here – thank you.”
- “Excellent teamwork, everyone is helping each other.”
- “I appreciate how you’re all following instructions.”

03. Encouraging Effort and Progress

- “I can see improvement in how you approached this task, well done.”
- “Your persistence is paying off, I can see it.”
- “It’s great to see you trying a new approach.”
- “Keep going, small steps lead to success.”

04. Whole Class Recognition

- “Thank you for listening, most of the class is ready to start.”
- “I’m noticing lots of good focus, well done everyone.”
- “I can see everyone trying their best today, it’s making a difference.”

05. Gentle Reminders with Positives

- “Thank you to those who are focused, I need everyone else to follow too.”
- “I appreciate those listening quietly, let’s help others catch up.”
- “Great start from most of the class, I need a few more to join in.”
