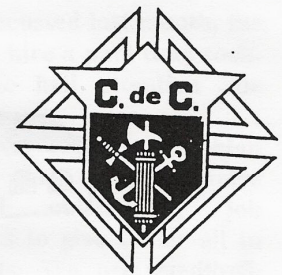

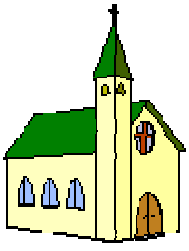

Happy New Year !!!!

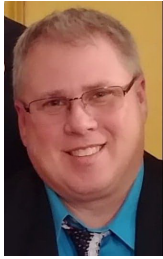
We had another busy month in December and looking forward to a great 2020!!!

There are several programs being run by State council. Some of them include Basketball Free Throw Contest, Substance Abuse Competition, Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest, and Keep Christ in Christmas Button Program. When you hold any event that involves minors or the vulnerable, two things you must know; a knowledge of Rowan's Law and members must have Safe Environment Training that is valid.

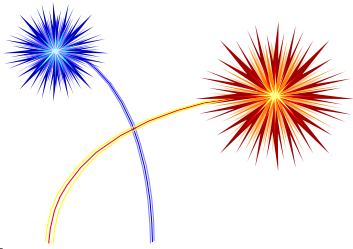

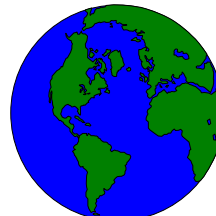
