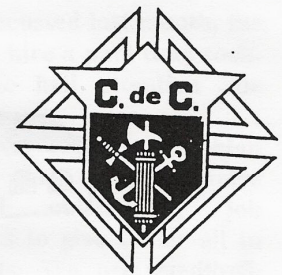

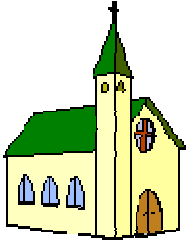

I attended the Bishop meeting on September 14 in London. Several topics were discussed during the meeting. Firstly, the family of parish update. When all changes are implemented there will be 30 pastor and 50 associate priests covering the dioceses of London. No current parishes or parish's council is to be closed.

Secondly, Fr Danny Santos is the new vocation director. There are 3 new seminaries bringing the total to 9 for the Diocese of London.

Thirdly, the Knights dinner with the bishop will be on November 16 in St Thomas at St. Anne Church. The bishop also encouraged that as Knights, we should work with the new pastors, actively participate in all church events and implement the new Supreme Faith/Action program within our new family of parishes. If there is more than one council in a family of parishes that they meet on a regular basis and coordinate activities so that they don't overlap.

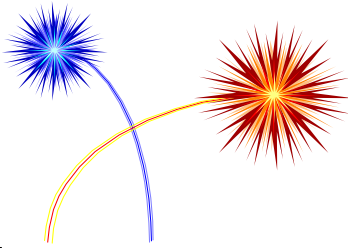

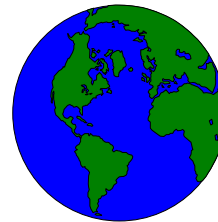
