From a Dream, A Prayer and a \$5.00 bill to Recovery.... Hope Homes has travelled 56 years of providing housing to individuals with DD and Special Needs. For 40 + years Hope Homes was recognized for its outstanding service to the community. Hope Homes provided direct care and housing to individuals. However, during a 10 year stretch of time from 2007 to mid 2017, poor business decisions and questionable leadership resulted in cooperate and financial concerns. Hope Homes suffered a major setback and was on the verge of closing its doors.

However, in mid-2017 Hope Homes began the "Road to Recovery" and with every setback a degree of light and wisdom arose. New leadership was put into place, as well as a strategic plan to limit its mission to housing and property maintenance only. Today we own 17 properties and lease them to 59 individuals and two Day Service Programs (50 participants). We initiated an "Aging in Place" service through Minor Home Repair and Modification program, as an approved Medicaid provider.

I have also learned that Hope Homes cannot do it alone, we need support, collaboration and the community to make the recovery complete. Please, join us with your ideas, donations and assistance on our Road to Recovery.
