**2023 Overview of Domestic and International Terrorism – Kevin Ford, FBI** With a perceived increase in threats and violence, learn to better recognize the presence of various types of terrorism activity. Hear an overview in the modern contexts to include 2023 events related to international and homeland events.

**American Red Cross Preparedness – Hands Only CPR - Bob Lorenz, American Red Cross** You can perform effective CPR by delivering only chest compressions. Hear the logic, see the techniques demonstrated and try for yourself. Also see what is offered for AED training.

**Accountability Without Blame: Put Yourself in That Person’s Shoes! Unfortunately, locks, cameras, security teams and preventive plans are as commonplace as Vacation Bible School, Sunday School and Choir Specials. We will address many of the issues we face today, including solo response.

**How Fentanyl Has Changed the Landscape of Drug Use - Alice McCaffrey - Sullivan County Anti-Drug Coalition** "Safe" recreational drug use is an outdated concept. Learn about the potency, effects, who is at risk, and practical steps to protect oneself and loved ones from the risk of overdose.
