Bravo Programs of America awards scholarships for tuition and books to young adults, aged 18 through 26, who have spent time in the foster care system. We support students who are enrolled in an accredited post-secondary education program with demonstrated leadership skills and have good academic standing. Besides financial support, we offer mentoring support, career counseling and access to resources to support you along your educational journey. One way or another, we are here to help.

To qualify for a scholarship from Bravo Programs of America, you must meet all of the following criteria:

- ❖ Have spent time in the foster care system.
- ❖ Be age 26 or younger at the beginning of the school term for which you are applying.
- ❖ Be enrolled in an accredited post-secondary education program.

In order for your application to be considered you must:

- ❖ Submit your completed application on or before the following date:
 - Fall Semester July 1st
 - Winter Semester November 15th
- ❖ Print clearly, and contact us immediately with updates if your contact information changes. If we are unable to contact you at any time during the application process, your application will be removed from consideration.
- ❖ Complete all sections, and attached all requested documentation, as noted in the following document checklist. ***Incomplete applications will not be considered.***

If you are selected to receive a scholarship

- You will receive confirmation via phone call and/or letter from a Bravo board member.
- Your scholarship check will be sent directly to your school in time to be applied to the upcoming term.
- Bravo will issue an announcement of the semester scholarship recipients on our social media platforms and may include the student profiles noted above. You will be given the opportunity to review and comment on your profile. If you do not provide feedback, we will use the profile as created.
- A Bravo “Buddy” will reach out to you after the start of the term to initiate communication. Your Buddy is your point of contact with Bravo should you have any questions or should you need any support. Your Buddy also helps us monitor the investment we have made in you by keeping aware of your school status. If your Buddy is unable to maintain communication with you, you will forfeit the opportunity for future Bravo scholarships.

If you are not selected to receive a scholarship

- You will receive an email notification. Your name and email address will be added to our mailing list so you receive communications about future scholarship opportunities.
