Our favorite foods are Royal Canin mother baby or Royal Canin kitten slices and gravy or the loaf and sauce, Fancy Feast tender beef feast classic, and Purina Pro Plan Beef and cheese entre. I feed a ½ to 1 can of wet in the AM and PM and always keep their bowl full of dry food. Our babies are still on Royal Canin Mother Baby dry and I've started to mix that with Blue Buffalo brands. I've also been trying Nulo kitten food. It's a new brand that has excellent protein content and a probiotic in it as well.

My adult cats absolutely love the Royal Canin Maine Coon breed specific brand. I mix that with the Blue buffalo brands. I also mix in a special order food called Lifesabundance. Check out www.lifesabundance.com to order.

For cat litter, I use the Dr Elsey's clay clumping or Tidy Cat unscented. Its dust free and scent free. No perfumes!!!! Stay away from covered litter boxes. These will be large cats and they won't have the room they need in a covered litter box. We love using www.Chewy.com for auto shipping and home delivery! (I'm pretty sure the FedEx guy hates me on kitty litter delivery day...)

Always keep fresh water available! This can be a challenge with your Maine Coon – they love water and love to play in it, splash in it and put their toys in it.....They all have a funny digging ritual before drinking. We keep a full water bowl right in the shower and bath tub. They can play in it – and you won't have to mop anything up. Be sure to keep your toilet lids shut while they are little.
