



Request to Speak (RTS) Sign Up Form

Request to Speak (RTS) is an online system that Arizona’s lawmakers use to collect feedback on pending legislative bills. The RTS system is an excellent tool that pediatric professionals can use to make their voices heard and advocate on important issues that affect the health and well-being of Arizona children and families. You may create an account in-person using a special kiosk at the state Capitol. The Arizona Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AzAAP) realizes it is not easy for all our members to make a trip to the state Capitol to create an account in-person using a special kiosk, especially if you live far from Phoenix. To make this process easier and to promote participation from our statewide membership, AzAAP can create a RTS account for you to access remotely.

This form will collect the relevant information we need to sign you up for the Arizona Legislative Information Service (ALIS) Request to Speak (RTS) system. By submitting this information, you are authorizing AzAAP to create a profile through the ALIS system on your behalf. We will never share this information with anyone but you, nor will we share or sell your email address.

Including your home address is helpful so we can best match you to the legislators that represent you. If you choose to participate, you can expect to receive emails from AzAAP requesting your participation through the RTS on a variety of timely and important issues throughout the Legislative Session.
