# HOME VISIT SAFETY CHECKLIST

#### IS YOUR BABY SLEEPING SAFELY?

# THINGS TO LOOK FOR: A separate sleeping space for the baby.

- ☐ Crib or bassinet in the room.
- ☐ Baby not sharing a bed.
- Sharing a room with parent/guardian until 1 year old.
- This separate sleeping space should have:
  - A firm mattress with a fitted sheet.
  - No bedding (blankets, pillows, bumpers).
  - ☐ No clutter (stuffed animals, toys).
- Room temperature should not be too warm.
  - If room temperature is comfortable for an adult, no extra heat is needed.
- ☐ No smoking in the baby's home.
