First degree (simple) Violations - 4 degrees each

Repeatedly being late for the morning assembly, not participating in it without an acceptable excuse, or being late on time of the class without an acceptable excuse.	1.1
Repeatedly entering and leaving class without permission, or not attending class or school activities without an excuse.	1.2
Non-compliance with school or sports uniform or not maintain it	1.3
Long Hair for boys or strange cuts for boys and girls.	1.4
Not bringing books and school supplies without an acceptable excuse.	1.5
Refusing to follow the rules of positive behavior inside and outside the classroom, maintaining calm, lack of discipline during the lesson and making inappropriate sounds inside and outside the classroom.	1.6
Falling asleep during class or official school activities without justification or permission (after checking the student's health condition).	1.7
Eating food during classes and during the morning queue without justification or permission, after checking the health status of the student.	1.8
lag behind to deliver the duties and assignments entrusted to him/her on time	1.9
Misuse of electronic devices such as tablets and others during the lesson, which includes playing electronic games and placing headphones in class.	1.10

Sexual harassment inside school or bus.	4.7

Possession, fetching, promotion or use of drugs, prescription drugs and psychotropic substances within the school, or appearing under the influence of drugs, narcotic drugs or mental effects	4.11

Insulting the heavenly religions and stirring up everything that causes sectarian and sectarian strife in the school	4.13
