

EEO Report

Seven Ranges Radio is licensed for three stations: WRRR-FM, St. Marys, WV, WXCR, New Martinsville, WV, and WVVV, Williamstown, WV.

Mid-Ohio Valley Radio Corporation is co-owned with Seven Ranges, and operates station WVAM (AM) Parkersburg, WV.

Seven Ranges Radio has five full time employees, Mid Ohio Valley Radio has three part-time employees, but no full-time employees. The full-time employees of Seven Ranges have additional duties with Mid Ohio Valley, but are paid by Seven Ranges.

During the time period June 2023 through May 27, 2024, no full-time employees were added to either company. An intern spent part of the summer at the St. Marys location, then was contracted for remote work for digital media updates. She left for a full time position with the local TV station. A part-time control room operator was also hired in July for remote and sports broadcasts. A high school student, he will be attending college out of the area next fall. His position will be replaced this summer. Marietta College, West Virginia University at Parkersburg, and Saint Marys High School were contacted when those positions opened, and will be contacted this summer for replacement part-time positions.

Outreach. Seven Ranges maintains contacts with Marietta College and WVUP, both institutions have active media programs. During 2023, one of the owners built a new studio for the Marietta College student run station, WCMO. He also prepared an application for a low power license to replace the restricted Class D license for that station, the low power station should be on air this summer.

The Washington County (Ohio) Career Center held a job fair in April which the stations promoted. We are unable to attend.
