Our aim is to create a caring, safe, fun, and encouraging environment for your child's dance journey.



Lending Costumes

- The costumes the studio supplies at concert time are lent at no extra cost to your weekly tuition.
- All costumes will be set up organised and ready for students at full dress rehearsal, our concert and photo day.
- You are not able to keep the costumes you will instead lend them and return them to Groove.

Parents only need to purchase some concert essentials items like stockings and shoes etc.







Fees are paid by Auto-Pay(Direct Debit) and directly linked to your Parent Portal. Auto-Pay is a quick and easy method of paying. You can log into your personal portal and set it up yourself or you can set it up at the studio with one of our teaching staff members.

If you are wanting payments to come out on a certain day, fortnightly or monthly please let us know via email.

You are able view any payments you have made on class fees in the Payment History of your private Parent Portal.

Zumba and Adult only classes are the only classes able to purchase a 10 class pass.



Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged weekly to your account. Over Christmas School holidays we close for a couple of weeks for the Christmas and New Years period. Your enrolment with us will continue unless we are notified by email. We require 8 day's notice.

We offer flexibility for guardians with children in our preschool dance classes. You can choose to wait in our waiting area(in our dance space) or actively participate in the class with your child. Participation in the dance space requires engagement to enhance the experience for everyone. Our classes are structured to foster independence, confidence, and social skills in preschoolers, preparing them for a future school environment. Our classes are a great opportunity for students to practice with just their teachers and other students and we are always focused on working towards students being confident and secure with in their self to be ready for this step. If you are unsure what you would like to do feel free to discuss this with us.



At this age your child may not participate in a 100% of each class every week and thats ok we work with each child at their learning pace. We are not expecting perfection especially at this age. Our preschool age classes are all about learning and sometimes that may mean sitting and watching or only participating in a few exercises.
