
Groove Dance was established in 2005 by owner and teacher Nerrida Bushell-Dennis

# Little Groover Classes

Our Little Groover classes cater for children from the age of 18months until they attend Primary School. We offer age appropriate classes and have created a nurturing enviroment, with classes capped at 10 children in each class, so each child will learn and develope their skills in dance and you can watch their confidence and self-esteem soar!



What you should expect from your child's age

A guardian is able to stay with this age group or drop their child off and pick them up at the end of their classes. If you are unsure what you would like to do feel free to discuss this with us. We also offer School readiness classes for students who are up to learning with out a parent in the

room.

### 18 months-3 years old

All children must be steady on their feet and walking to participate.
With in a few lessons students will start to learn to stand on their spot to learn a movement.
With in a few lessons students start to participate in 1 or more exercises per class.


3years-5years old

As students start to attend regular lessons they will participate in more exercises and movements each week and build on their learning and listening skills.
Co-ordination will improve as each term progresses.

At this age your child may not participate in a 100% of each class every week and thats ok we work with each child at their learning pace. We are not expecting perfection especially at this age. Our Little Groover classes are all about learning and sometimes that may mean sitting and watching or only participating in a few exercises. Consistancy and weekly attendence is important for our youngest students.

#### What to wear


It's time to dress up in your favourite princess outfit. Students can wear anything they are comfortable to move around in with secure and safe shoes like ballet shoes or sports joggers.

Cost and Payment of class fees

Fees are paid by Auto-Pay(Direct Debit) and directly linked to your Parent Portal. Auto-Pay is a quick and easy method of paying and is set up at the studio by one of our staff members or you can log into your personal portal and set it up yourself.

If you are wanting payments to come out on a certain day, fortnightly or monthly please let us know upon set up.

You are able view any payments you have made on class fees in the Payment History of your private Parent Portal.

### Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged weekly to your invoice and we run classes roughly in line with the NSW Public School Term. Your enrolment with us will continue each term unless we are notified by email.

Auto-Pay (direct debit) is one of only 2 payment options available for our dance classes and one of the reasons we are able to offer affordable dance classes. We are registered providers of the Active and Creative Kids Vouchers and they can be used for dance classes once you have enrolled and set up your Auto-Pay Payments.

Both discounts per students and family cannot be combined. Payments must be direct debited using Auto-Pay. Online level up classes cannot be used as the first 3 classes you pay for per week butare free for students who receive our unlimited discount.

This discount can be used for classes on different days they do not just have to be onthe same day and can be the same class on a different day.

Comfortable active clothes can be worn to class each week.

Shoes

Comfortable sports shoes can be worn for most weekly classes. What shoes need to be purchased for our Annual Dance Concert depends on which class your child does. Once students are enroled in a class you can veiw the options for shoes in your personal portal under class files. Shoes can be purchased anytime prior to our Annual Dance Concert. Our tap shoe colour we use is camel.





# Concert Information Pack

We send out a Concert information pack prior to our Annual Concert so parents can go through the information and decide is this is something they want to put their name down for. It is not compulsory to participate in our Annual Dance Concert but if you do decide to complete the concert waiver to commit at concert time your account will be charged accordingly.

### **Concert** Time

Our Annual Dance Concert is held near the middle of each year. Our concert is away from Christmas which gives everyone the opportunity to enjoy without having lots of extra costs and commitments that come along with the end of each year.

# What Happens After the Concert?

After our concert we start working on all new dances for our next concert. We also do a mini concert at the end of the year with very little commitment from our students and families needed. Last year we held a charity concert were the audience paid \$6 to watch and it was all donated to Ronald McDonald House Newcastle.

## Costumes at Concert Time

### Concert Information Book

All students enrolled at Groove will receive a concert information book at Concert time with all the dates and information you require.

We have 2 options available for costumes at concert time and detailed information on both options will be outlined in the concert information book so you can make the choice best for you.



#### Option One

- You can lend the costumes the studio supplies at concert time.
- All our costumes will be set up organised and ready for students at full dress rehearsal, our concert and photo day.
- You are not able to keep the costumes you will instead lend them and return them to Groove.

### Option Two

- You can purchase the costumes the studio supplies at concert time.
- All costumes will be set up and organised and ready for students at full dress rehearsal and our concert.
- Most classes do 2 dances in our annual concert and our costumes range anywhere between approximately \$20-\$60 each costume. Please note the amount is an estimate and could be either less or more expensive depending on the dance and costume required.
