EASY BACKUPS

A rainy forecast does not have to become an all-day family group project.

Updated August 2026

Choose by energy, not just weather

Rain often pushes every family indoors at once. The best backup plan matches the room, noise level, age range, and patience available that day.

Documented sensory support

The venue publicly identifies accommodations or scheduled sensory programming. Confirm the date, availability, and current process before leaving.

Self-paced

You control how quickly you move and can usually leave a section without interrupting a show or scheduled activity.

High energy

Expect arcade sounds, music, flashing lights, physical activity, crowds, or competition - especially during a downpour.

Gentler timing

The experience may be easier at opening, on a weekday, or after the first rain rush. This is a planning note, not a formal accommodation.

The rainy-day comfort kit

PACK	PREVIEW	PROTECT THE RESET
Headphones, sunglasses, comfort item, dry socks, snack	Show the parking, entrance, ticket line, bathrooms, and first activity	Choose one anchor activity; keep the condo, movie, or quiet meal as the second half

For thunder, flooding, high wind, tornado warnings, or tropical weather, follow official alerts and property instructions. An attraction plan can wait.

Four strong indoor anchors

These can carry most of a rainy morning or afternoon. Check current hours, tickets, and event schedules before driving.

SENSORY SUPPORT ALL AGES

Ripley's Aquarium of Myrtle Beach

Sharks, rays, penguins, jellyfish, and the underwater tunnel make this a dependable all-ages anchor. Sensory-friendly events include adjusted lighting, a music-free environment, a quiet room, and headphones upon request.

SENSORY EVENTS AGES 0-10

EdVenture Myrtle Beach

A compact children's museum designed primarily for ages 0-10, with hands-on, imaginative play. Its calendar currently includes select Sensory Nights; verify the event date and admission details.

WonderWorks Myrtle Beach

More than 100 hands-on exhibits blend science and high-energy play. The inversion tunnel, lights, motion, and busy zones can be intense; scheduled Sensory Days offer a modified experience.

Hollywood Wax Museum

A self-paced photo experience with props and interactive moments. The wax museum is the gentler choice in the complex; the mirror maze and zombie attraction add darkness, disorientation, and jump-scare energy.

These are good for families who want to play instead of browse. Downside: they are usually loudest when the weather is worst.

Bowling, arcade games, billiards, simulators, and food under one roof. Reserve a lane when possible and ask about the quietest seating area.

MARKET COMMON

Grand 14 at The Market Common

A movie is the easiest low-decision backup. Choose seats near an aisle, preview the rating and runtime, and pair it with a quiet snack or stroll when the rain eases.

BOARDWALK

Fun Plaza Arcade

Classic and modern arcade games sit on the Myrtle Beach Boardwalk. It is convenient and memorable, but expect full lights-and-sounds energy during peak rainy hours.

FREE OR LOW COST

The condo reset

Board games, a movie, takeout, an indoor pool if your property includes one, and a dry-clothes reset can save the whole day. Vacation does not require maximizing every hour.

Three no-drama rainy-day plans

One anchor, one meal, one reset. That is enough.

AGES 0-10 LOWER STAKES

Little-kid morning

Opening time at EdVenture, early lunch at The Market Common, then nap or movie time back at the property. Add nothing unless everyone still has energy.

ALL AGES FLEXIBLE

Mixed-age family

Aquarium first, choose-your-own lunch at Broadway at the Beach, then split: one group shops or rests while the other plays.

HIGH ENERGY TEENS + TWEENS

Big-kid energy

WonderWorks or bowling, one casual meal, then a movie or property reset. Skip stacking two arcades unless your family genuinely enjoys full-volume fun.

PLAN AHEAD COMFORT FIRST

Sensory-conscious plan

Choose a documented sensory event when dates align. Otherwise arrive at opening, ask staff about quiet space before entering, and keep your exit plan simple.

Before leaving the property

| [] Check the attraction's official site for same-day hours and ticket availability. | [] Check radar and local safety alerts - not only the hourly weather icon. |
| [] Confirm parking, stroller rules, outside food policy, and re-entry. | [] Ask directly about current sensory resources or quiet-space availability. |
| [] Pack a dry layer; heavily air-conditioned indoor attractions can feel cold. | [] Choose the meal before everyone becomes hungry and over it. |
