The term "homestay" refers to out-of-town Shadow Drum and Bugle Corps (DBC) members that live with local Oregon, WI families during the summer tour season. Living situations will vary in each household. Some host families will be able to provide their homestay(s) with separate bedrooms, some may share a bedroom and others may utilize a common space in the house, i.e. living/recreation room. In each instance the host family will be expected to provide a clean, safe environment for their out-of-town homestay.

In return the homestays are required to be respectful of the host family's household rules. These rules should be discussed and agreed upon prior to the start of the season.

The host family is expected to provide meals for their homestay when the homestay is not on tour. Some homestays will choose to eat out for some meals while others will choose to return to their host family's house for their meals. The host family and homestay should communicate these preferences prior to the start of the summer season and on an ongoing daily basis.

The host family will:

- Provide a safe, clean living environment.
- Provide meals for the homestay as agreed upon prior to the start of the summer season.
- Provide transportation as necessary to and from rehearsals and performance events.
- Allow the homestay to utilize laundry facilities.
- Will contact the Housing Coordinator if any unresolvable issues with the homestay arise.
- Receive a \$300 credit per homestay. The credit can be taken as \$300 credit on next season's tuition or as \$150 in grocery gift cards now and \$150 credit on next season's invoice. If the host child is an age-out the invoice credit will be applied to this season, otherwise it will be applied to next season.

The homestay is required to:

- Keep their living environment clean.
- Be respectful of the host family's household rules.
- Inform the host family if they will not be returning "home" after an event or for an evening. The homestay's parents need to consent to overnight stays away from the host family's house.
- Inform the host family of any special needs, allergies, or dietary restrictions.
- Will contact the Housing Coordinator if any unresolvable issues with the host family arise.
