Türkiye and Syria Update

Thank you to all members of our community who were so generous with their donations to victims of the earthquakes in Türkiye and Syria.

\$150,000 was sent in the first week to cover emergency shelter, medical care (field hospital) and food. The attached videos capture the impact of the funds from Windsor on the initial response to the disaster.

On the recommendation of people on the ground and all relief agencies, the remaining funds will be used to secure permanent shelter for those who lost everything. More videos of WIA and Windsor sponsored shelter projects will follow inshaAllah.

RAMADAN MASJID RULES





PARKING: Parking is allowed in designated areas only. Your vehicle may be ticketed or towed if it is parked illegally on the streets, private driveways, handicap spots, or if it is blocking two spots or obstructing public driveways.



TRAFFIC: WIA traffic control volunteers may open or close entrances or exits around the Mosque parking lots depending on the traffic conditions. Please obey their

SWITCHES & CONTROLS: Unauthorized individuals are strictly prohibited from fiddling with switches, controls lights, air-conditioning, sound system, audio-visual and so on. Please request one of the official WIA volunteers to pass your request to the maintenance dept. If there is such a need anywhere in the Hosque.



Please DO NOT BRING FOOD OR DRINKS INSIDE PRAYER AREAS. Please do your best to keep the Masjid clean at all times during Ramadan.



NO RESERVATIONS: This Masjid is a public place. You MAY NOT HOLD YOUR SPOT inside the Masjid by placing personal belongings. Spaces are limited and are available on a first come first serve basis. Please find another spot if you have to leave your place

CLEAN-UP, RECYCLE WASTE: Please recycle your waste wherever possible, pick up and dispose your garbage into designated containers, do not throw soiled napkins on the carpet or the floor, do not walk on the carpets with wet / dripping clothes and feet, keep your flasjid clean at all times.
