The **University of Montana Pro-Am show** was redesigned this year. Scott Kuehn has long had the vision for the pro competitors to coach and assist the college competitors at this show. Scott really got the ball rolling in the right direction, and he handed the reigns off to Eric Hoberg this year. Scott still runs the Forestry Days celebration that the Pro-Am is a part of. Attendees can see old time logging equipment and practices throughout historic fort Missoula including a steam powered saw mill. Eric added food trucks this year, and they all sold out of food! Eric also changed to a flight schedule similar to the old PNE show style with 4 distinct shows running about an hour each. This allowed attendees to see almost every event in a 1-hour time period and allowed competitors time to reset before the next show. The ALA sponsored prize money for 3 events where a pro was paired with a college student in an event. The jack & jill, butcher block underhand, and standing events allowed college students a chance to get some experience and coaching from pros. There were also some clinics for the students after the competition. The weather really cooperated and the event as a whole was a huge success!
