**Luther Memorial Launches Micah's Mini-Pantry for Virginia Tech Students**

**Blacksburg, Virginia** ---Luther Memorial Lutheran Church, together with The Well Campus Ministry, has installed a new food pantry on their property at 600 Prices Fork Road in Blacksburg. The pantry, known as "Micah's Mini-Pantry at Luther Memorial", is located outside The Well Campus Ministry Campus Center off Tom's Creek Road. The pantry is stocked with non-perishable foods and personal hygiene products; all items are available for free to anyone in need, but our goal is to specifically address Virginia Tech student food insecurity, especially with international graduate students.

Pastor Libby Pfaff, pastor to The Well Campus Ministry at Virginia Tech, a campus ministry of Luther Memorial Lutheran Church in Blacksburg, says, "Although data on food insecurity among college students is limited, a fall 2020 survey conducted by Temple University's Hope Center for College, Community and Justice, which studies basic needs insecurity for college students, found that 34% of college students experienced food insecurity in the prior 30 days."<sup>1</sup>

“We are so grateful for all who helped make this pantry a reality, including Boy Scout Troop 704 who helped with the installation. Hopefully Micah’s Mini-Pantry will alleviate some worry for those students who struggle to meet basic needs and help to eliminate a barrier to graduating,” says Pastor Monica Weber, Pastor at Luther Memorial Lutheran Church. “A survey conducted by the national nonprofit group [Swipe Out Hunger](#) found that 52% of students sometimes used off-campus food banks, while 30% used them monthly or more frequently.<sup>2</sup>

This ministry is a “satellite” program to the Micah’s Backpack Initiative at St. Michael Lutheran Church in Blacksburg, which addresses food insecurity of youth in local schools. The backpack program delivers six weekend meals plus snacks directly to 279 students in 10 Blacksburg schools.
