Change for Change – Montgomery County Emergency Assistance Program



The Montgomery County Emergency
Assistance Program (MCEAP) is a 100%
volunteer-run organization with zero
overhead cost, and strongly believes in
providing a hand up instead of a handout.
MCEAP's operations run entirely from
donations and profits from their thrift store.
They can provide food, clothing, household

items, and financial assistance to fill needs that other agencies are unable to meet. Their mission is to assist Montgomery County residents in maintaining their households and restoring their self-sufficiency. This can be achieved by serving the immediate, emergency, and temporary needs of low-income, unemployed, elderly, or handicapped individuals and families.

Good Shepherd Fund



The Good Shepherd fund at Luther Memorial helps defray costs associated with emergency situations that someone in our community might face. The fund is considered a means of last resource. In the past, we have paid for utilities, rent, transportation costs, temporary housing, car repair, and car payments. Over the last year,

we have spent over \$6,900 to help our fellow citizens.

The fund is managed by the Social Ministry Committee. We review and vote on all requests. The congregation can petition for aid for anyone in need in our community. This is a simple and fast process.
