Blackburg Interfaith Food Pantry



In 2026, Social Ministry will be focusing on four special appeal projects. There will be one appeal each quarter. They are Blacksburg Interfaith Food Pantry, Micah's Closet, To Our House, and the Christmas Project for Valley Interfaith Childcare Center.

Blackburg Interfaith Food Pantry – First Quarter

For January, February, and March, we will be discussing the importance of our local Food Pantry and how Luther Memorial helps the hunger insecure in our community. Currently we purchase all the soap for the Pantry. In 2025, we donated 5,070 bars of soap. We also purchased 710 boxes of Jiffy Cornbread mix and 275 cans of Cream of Mushroom soup for the Pantry's annual holiday bags. As a bonus, we had enough money donated to purchase 246 large cans of chicken when the Pantry ran low last winter. To continue these projects, we would like to raise \$5,000 during the quarter. Luther Memorial has 11 members from the congregation that regularly volunteer at the Pantry.

From the Pantry - Thanksgiving Gratitude

A customer said before they shopped, she wanted to let us know how much she appreciated the Thanksgiving dinner. She said, "We wouldn't have had Thanksgiving dinner without you all. I hope you know how much that means to us."

Another customer, with a family of four, has been walking a mile after work to take a bus to the closest stop to the food pantry and then trying to get home with her groceries, also on the bus.
