“Rainbow Connection” LGBTQIA+ Ministry Meets Sunday, June 5, 2022

Blacksburg, Virginia --- On June 5, 2022, at 4 pm, Luther Memorial Lutheran Church and The Well Campus Ministry will hold a gathering of the “Rainbow Connection” ministry, a safe, non-judgmental space for LGBTQIA+ persons and allies. This gathering will take place in the Fellowship Hall at Luther Memorial, located at 600 Prices Fork Road in Blacksburg. The Rainbow Connection is intended to be intergenerational, open to anyone in the Blacksburg area aged 18+ who wishes to socialize, network, and share their concerns and experiences. Students, faculty, and staff from Virginia Tech are encouraged to participate in this ecumenical, interfaith community.

Reverend Monica Weber, lead pastor at Luther Memorial, says “Our congregation voted in 2003 to become a Reconciling in Christ body, to provide an accepting, affirming, inclusive faith community in Blacksburg that reflects God’s embrace of all persons, just as they are. In 2021, The Well Campus Ministry at Luther Memorial also became a Reconciling in Christ body, and together we partner to provide a safe space for the LBGQTQIA+ population and their allies and

families in the New River Valley area. We intend for this ministry to become a community where all are accepted as God created them, where like-minded folks can make friends, find support and encouragement, and speak freely about the challenges they face in a world that is often hostile.”

The Rainbow Connection meets on the first Sunday of each month at 4 pm in the Luther Memorial Lutheran Church Fellowship Hall, with the possibility of more frequent meetings in future.
