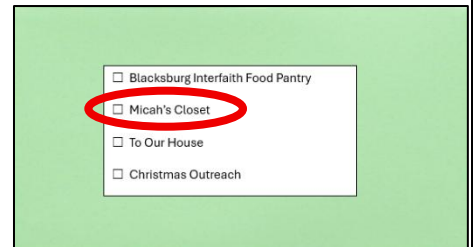
Micah's Closet –Second Quarter Collection



Micah's Closet is a program where Luther Memorial adopts children at Eastern Montgomery Elementary School who need new clothes. Micah's Closet works closely with the school staff and school counselor. The school staff and school counselor select the children who need clothes (identities are kept confidential) and provide the sizes for members of our congregation to shop.

The cost of a week's worth of clothes runs from \$185 to \$200 depending on the age of the child. In the fall each child is provided with 5 pairs of pants, 7 long sleeve shirts, 5-10 pairs of underwear, 7 to 10 pairs of socks, a light jacket/ hoodie and 1 pair of PJs. In the spring we provide each child with 2 pairs of pants, 3 pairs of shorts, 7 short sleeve shirts, 5-10 pairs of underwear, 7 to 10 pairs of socks, one jacket/hoodie and one pair of PJs.

The money that is raised during the second quarter (April through June) will go towards purchasing clothes in the spring and fall. Our goal is \$4,000. Envelopes are on the table before you enter the sanctuary.



Blacksburg Interfaith Food Pantry Update

During the first quarter, \$2,425 in donations were collected towards our goal of \$5,000 for the Food Pantry to purchase soap and contribute towards the holiday bags. We also received a \$500 grant from the ELCA which will be used for the purchase of food for the holiday bags. In addition, we have \$1,800 in pledges for continuing support of the Food Pantry.



Luther Memorial's goal for the Just One Can Campaign was to collect 150 cans towards the Pantry's goal of 30,000 cans. We collected 201 cans!

Thank you to everyone who donated for the purchase of soap and the holiday bag for the Pantry as well as bringing cans of food. We do collect food year around so when you are spring cleaning your Pantry and you know you will not eat that can of soup consider donating it to the Pantry.
