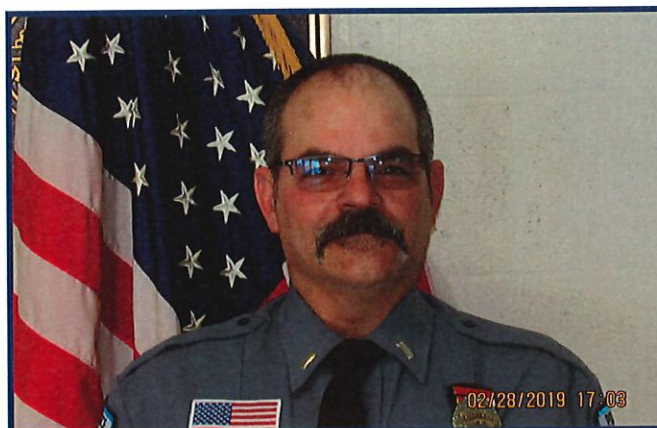

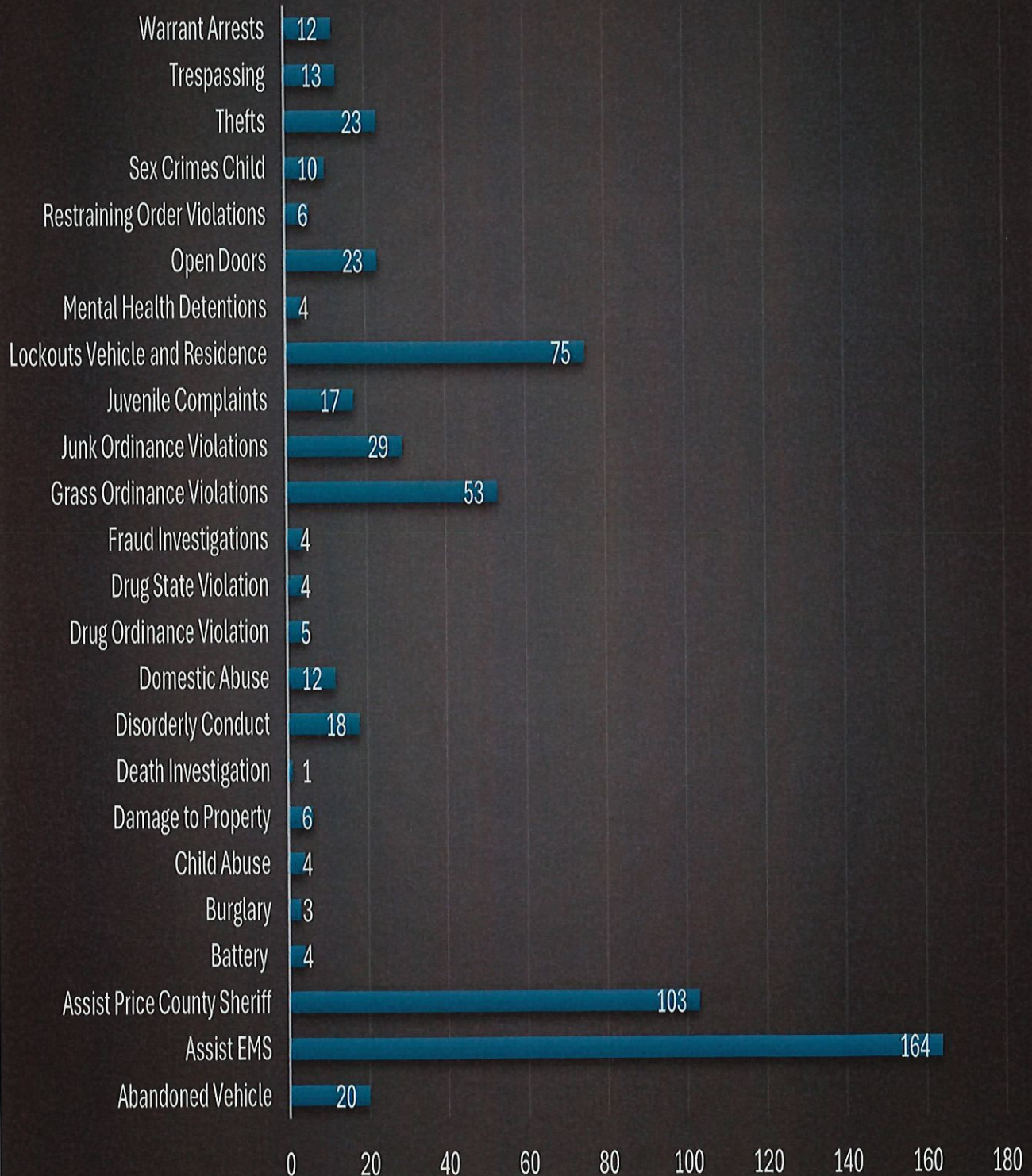

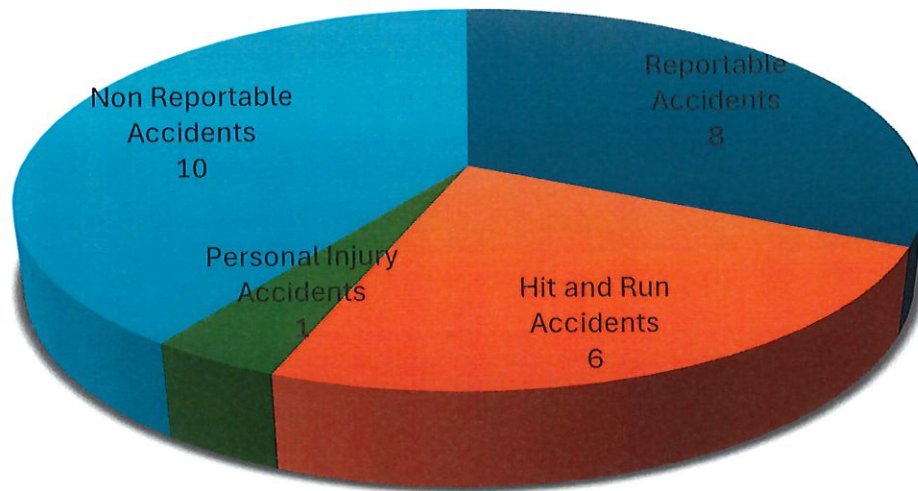

2024 Sample of 1793 Calls for Service



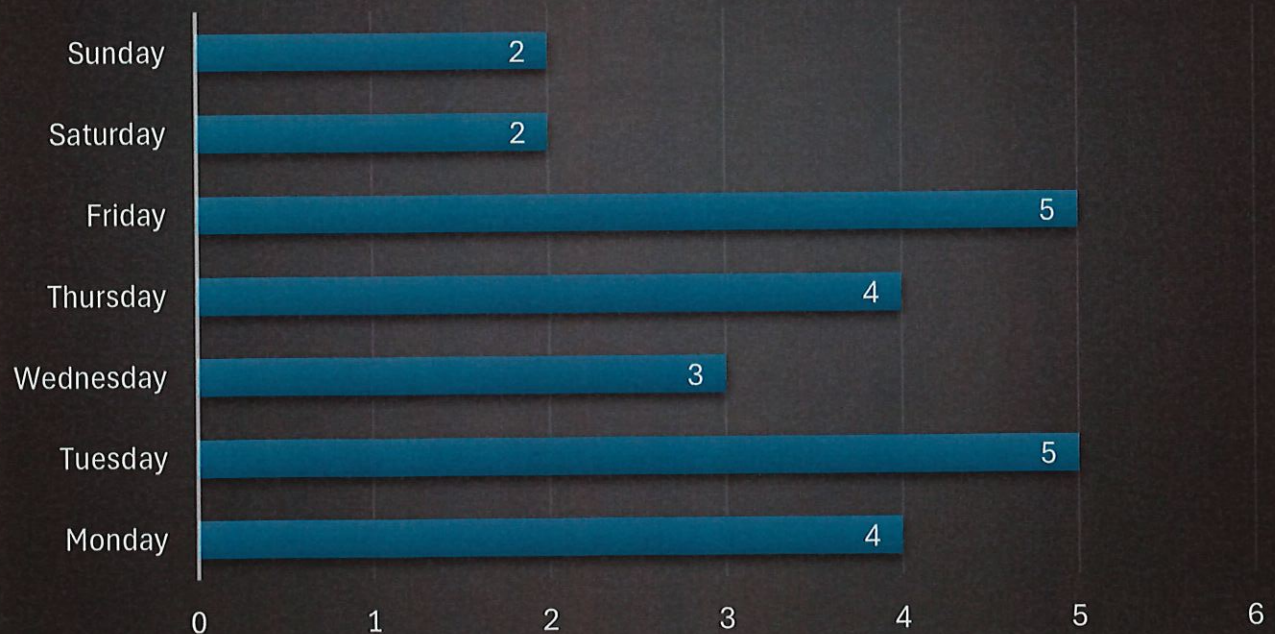

2024 Reported Accidents



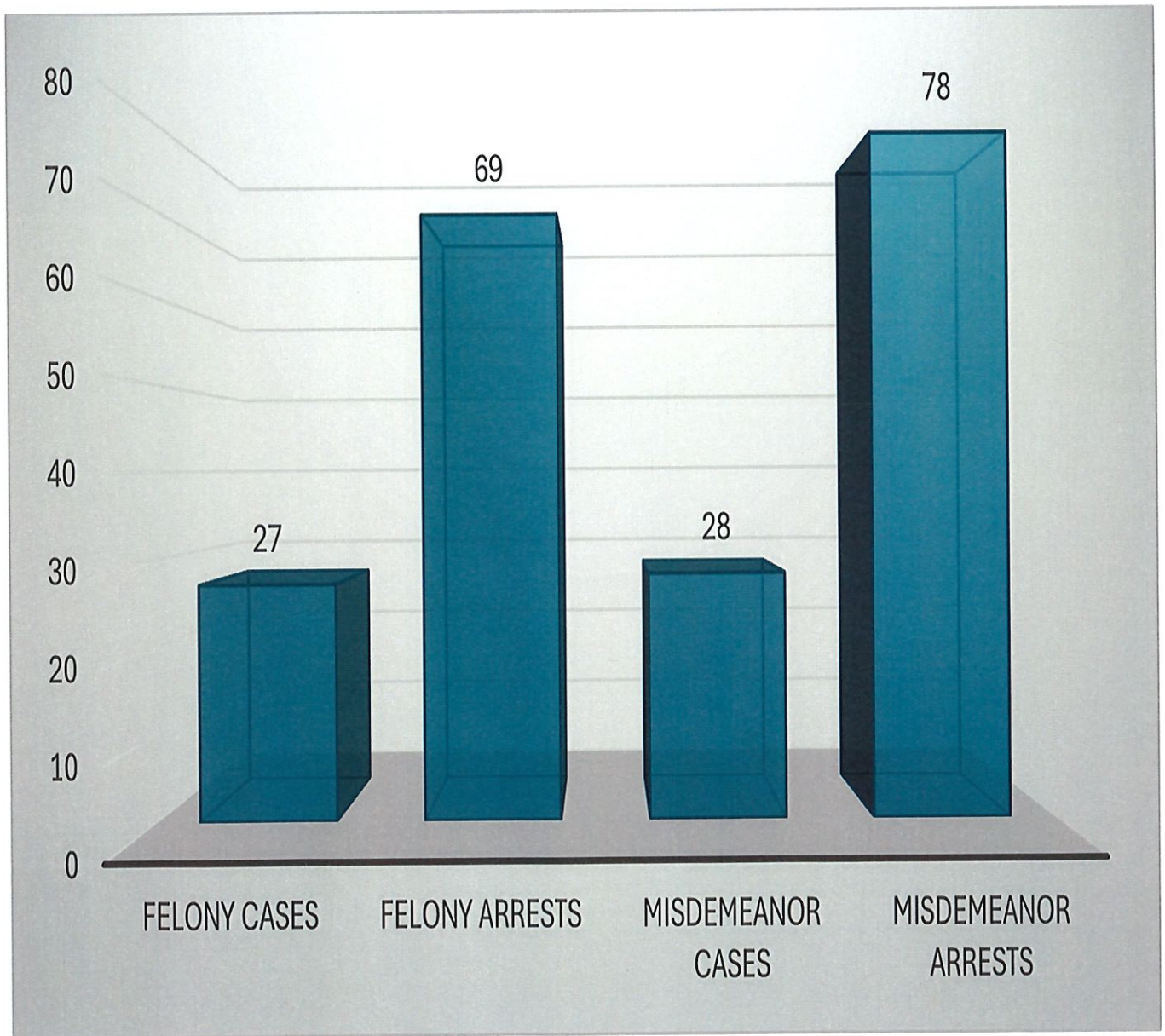
■ Reportable Accidents ■ Hit and Run Accidents

2024 Accidents by Day of Week

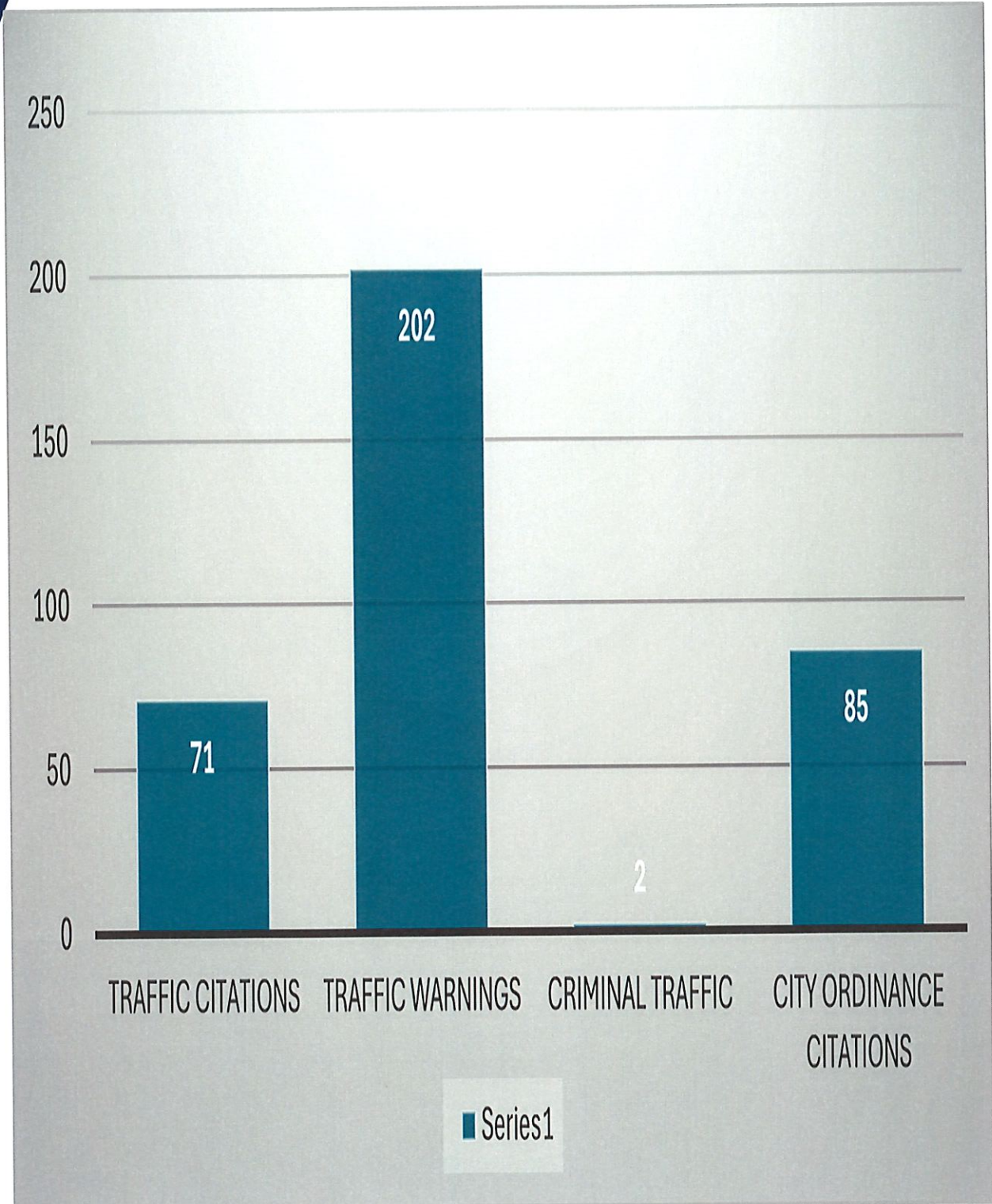


2024 Arrests

Cases by Felony and Misdemeanor and Corresponding Arrests

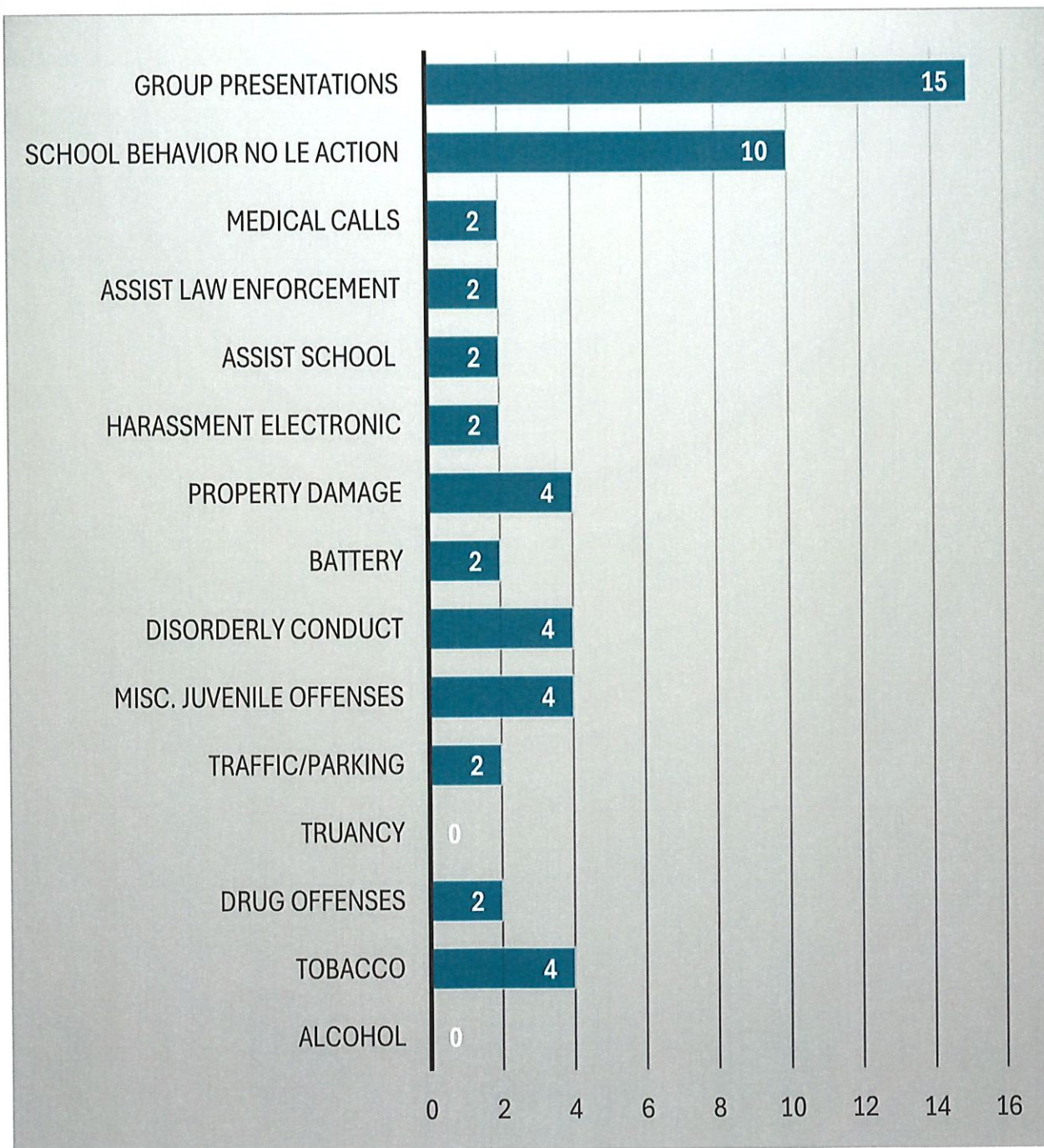

Total Weight of Methamphetamine Seized – 4.01 grams

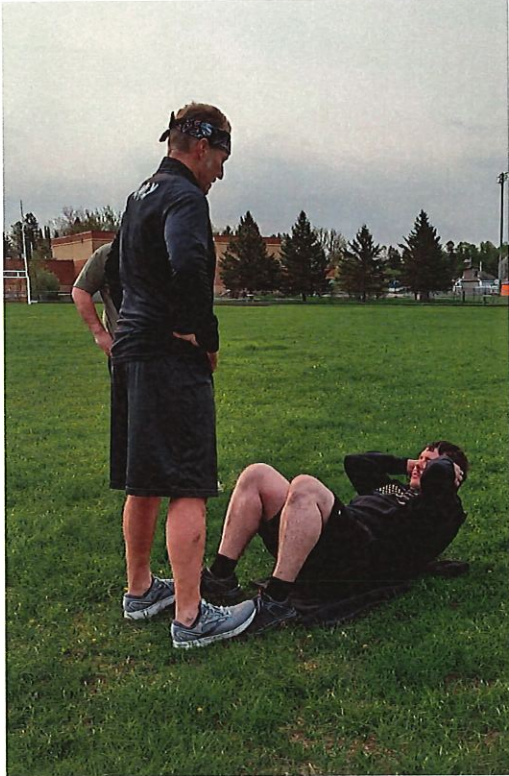
2 Drug Search Warrants Executed
