

Admission Procedures

Our easy three-step admission process.

Step One: Outdoor Classroom Observation

In response to the need to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19, Montessori Villa classrooms are currently closed to visitors. Only students, faculty, staff, and essential school personnel are able to enter the building.

Please schedule a 10 minutes observation of our classroom via the outdoor porch.

Step Two: Set Up a Meeting via Zoom

Once you have seen the school/ class schedule a 1:1 Zoom meeting with Maria Arif. This meeting is an opportunity to have your admissions questions answered and to become acquainted with Montessori Villa. Schedule your zoom session and classroom observation via email or phone.

Step Three: Submit an Application

Please submit the [Online Application](#). Completed applications must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$100. After this, applications will be reviewed and admission will be offered to qualified candidates on a space-available basis.

Step Four: Complete Enrollment Forms/Choose Start Date

Policy
