

# Enchanted Farmhouse Kitchen Update (Stage 1):

# Our Journey

Hey there! Welcome back to the Enchanted Farmhouse! I've been dying to share with you all the exciting updates we've made to our kitchen—it's been such a whirlwind of projects, but we're finally at the end of our "Stage One" updates, and I couldn't be more thrilled with how everything turned out. You know how much I love getting my hands dirty (well, sometimes literally) with these projects, and I've got to tell you, this kitchen update has been a labor of love.

So, grab a cup of coffee or tea, and let me walk you through every little detail of our Enchanted Farmhouse Kitchen transformation!

### Gathering My Tools and Supplies: Prepping for the Update

As you know, any good project starts with gathering the right tools and supplies. I'm no stranger to DIY projects, but it's always worth ensuring I have everything ready before diving in. Here's what I ended up pulling together:

- Bercom Handy 1600-6 Roller Cup It's like the perfect little helper when you need a small amount of paint for those tight spots.
- Handy Paint Roller Cup Liners Lifesavers when it comes to quick clean-up.
   Trust me, you want these!
- Pro Grade Paint Roller Tool Kit 10 Piece Painting Set This was great for giving me all the brushes and rollers I needed for both detailed work and larger surfaces.
- Pro Grade Paint Brushes 5-Piece Flat and Angle Paint Brush Set These
   brushes are just awesome for both precision and coverage.
- 3M High Strength Small Hole Filler, 3 oz. Because who doesn't find random holes when they're painting? Seriously though, this includes filler, a putty knife, and a sanding pad all in one product. I love the ease!
- <u>Dry Dex Spackling</u> For those surprise dings and dents I didn't see before starting.
- <u>BLACK+DECKER Electric Screwdriver, Cordless</u> I don't know how I lived without this! Made installing the new cabinet hardware so much easier (and all of my other projects as well!.



### Painting the Cabinets: My All-Time Favorite Paint

Let me tell you, this part was both exciting and a little nerve-wracking! Painting cabinets is a serious commitment, but I couldn't be happier with how they turned out. For the lower cabinets, I used <u>Heirloom Traditions All in One Paint in Iron Gate</u>, which is such a rich, deep color that grounds the space beautifully. And for the upper cabinets, I went with <u>Heirloom Traditions All in One Paint in Cashmere</u>, a creamy, soft hue that keeps everything feeling light and airy.

I've used these paints before (remember how much I raved about them when we did our bathrooms and kitchen in the old house?), and they did not disappoint this time around either. They go on like a dream, dry quickly, and the finish is so smooth. One of my tricks from last time, though, was to add a top layer of <u>Gilden Grab n Go</u>

Black Semi-Gloss to the lower cabinets. I had used this on my kitchen island in the old place, and it held up like a champ against all the banging and kicking it endured. So, I figured why not do the same here?

The best part? It only took a couple of coats, and boom—instant transformation. I've got to say, I'm pretty proud of myself on this one.



## Painting the Walls and Trim: Soft and Subtle Colors

Next up, the walls! I wanted something that would complement the cabinets without overpowering them, so I chose <u>Sherwin-Williams Faded Flaxflower SW9146</u> for the walls. It's this lovely, understated blue that adds just the right touch of color without being too bold. It's one of those colors that feels neutral but still has personality.

For the trim, I used <u>Sherwin-Williams Pure White SW7005</u>, and oh my goodness, it just makes everything pop! The contrast between the Faded Flaxflower on the walls and the crisp white trim is everything I hoped for. Plus, the semi-gloss finish on the trim gives it a polished look that makes the whole room feel fresh and clean.



### **Cabinet Hardware: The Finishing Touch**

I've always believed that hardware is like jewelry for your cabinets—it's the little detail that makes a big difference. For this update, I chose <u>Ravinte Matte Black</u>

<u>Square Kitchen Cabinet Knobs</u> and <u>Goldenwarm 3 Inch Black Cabinet Handles</u>. I used the same ones in our previous home when I updated my cabinets last fall. They had that perfect combination of modern and farmhouse vibes, so I knew they'd be perfect here too.

Installing them was a breeze with my trusty <u>BLACK+DECKER Electric Screwdriver</u>. I swear, that tool saved me so much time. And let me tell you, these black matte handles and knobs just elevate the whole kitchen—they make everything look so sleek and modern while still feeling homey.

The final touch was adding three <u>SEENMING HOUSE blue blown glass pendant</u> <u>lights</u> over the counter. I absolutely love how it transformed the space.



### Flooring: Empire to the Rescue

Ah, the floors. This was the one part of the project I outsourced because, honestly, I've learned my limits, and flooring is one of them! After getting four quotes (yes, four—I'm thorough like that), we decided to go with **Empire**. They had done the LVP (luxury vinyl plank) flooring in our previous home, and we were really happy with their work.

This time, we chose <u>Lattitude LVP - Range</u> I love how it gives the kitchen a warm, inviting feel, but it's also super durable and easy to clean—two must-haves for any kitchen, right? The team at Empire was fantastic. They worked quickly, did a flawless job, and left everything spotless. I can't recommend them enough.



## Personal Touches: Decorating the Space

Now for the fun part—decorating! You know I love adding those little finishing touches that make a room feel personal and lived-in. One of my favorite pieces is the **Excelloj Global Products Wooden Rustic Magnetic Chalkboard**. It's functional but also adds a bit of charm to the space. Plus, I love having a place to jot down notes and hang my keys.

By the sink we added a matte black towel ring for our kitchen towels. I had purchased a 20 piece set bathroom hardware set by Ruby Q for the updating we are doing, and the towel ring fit perfectly in that space.

I also added a <u>Selman 4 Bottle Solid Wood Tabletop Wine Bottle & Glass</u>

<u>Rack</u>—because, well, wine. It's such a cute and practical piece that fits perfectly on the counter without taking up too much space. With our wine rack in the basement,

this rack will be perfect to hold just a few bottles.

For the kitchen floor, I found the perfect <u>buffalo plaid Foneyi runner rug</u> to tie everything together. It adds warmth and texture, plus it's great for standing while do dishes.


#### Reflecting on the Process: A Team Effort
