Sensory Play



Tummy Time with Mirrors



Materials:

- Soft fabric squares
- Crinkly paper
- Textured toys

Activity: Create a sensory bin with a variety of textures. Let the baby explore different fabrics, crinkly paper, and textured toys. This stimulates their sense of touch and encourages curiosity.

Materials:

- Baby-safe mirror
- Soft mat

Activity: Place a baby-safe mirror on the floor during tummy time. Babies love looking at their reflections, which helps develop their visual tracking skills and encourages them to lift their heads.

Musical Exploration Materials: • Rattles



Soft drum
Baby-safe musical instruments
Activity: Introduce your baby to different sounds by letting them play with baby-safe musical

instruments. Shake a rattle, tap a

soft drum, or let them explore a baby piano.

Peek-a-Boo



Materials:

- Soft blanket
- Baby's favorite toy Activity: Play peek-a-boo with a soft blanket or their favorite toy. This simple game helps develop object permanence, understanding that objects still exist even when they can't see them. Tip: Use exaggerated facial expressions.

Reading Time



Materials:

- Board books
- Cloth books

Activity: Read to your baby every day. Choose colorful board books or cloth books with simple pictures and words. Point to the pictures and describe them to your baby.
