





# Food Passport

- Participants must have a food passport in hand to obtain a food sample
- Multiple food passports can be purchased at the gate if they would like more than one sample
- \$10.00 per passport
- Sponsors will have pre-paid food passport envelopes at the Kaufman's volunteer table






## Beer and Pepsi Stands

# Hey you! You're using a Porta Potty in a public place.... I bet you want to wash your hands when you're done, right? Luckily you can!



But not everyone is that lucky...
In Guatemala, for example, an estimated 49% of the rural population does not have access to the basic resources necessary for proper hygiene.





Organización Buenos Vecinos, a Guatemalan based group of engineers, medical workers, and all around "good neighbors", are doing something to help. With the support of Rotary International they are installing affordable, sustainable, and effective handwashing stations, known as Tippy Taps, across their country one community at a time.

Tap has even allowed schools
in Guatemala to be able to open
again amidst the pandemic,
simply by providing access to
hand washing.

## A Special Cause: Tippy Taps

- A portion of beverage sales will go towards a Rotary International initiative our club supports called 'Tippy Taps'.
- 80% of human diseases are water borne and we can greatly reduce disease by hand washing and drinking pure water.
- A 'Tippy Tap' will be at the event for demonstration next to the Beer and Wine stand.
