Greetings to you in the name of Christ.

I am writing to you in my capacity as the Canadian Shield Regional Minister, on behalf of the Support to Communities of Faith Commission, with an invitation for the next steps in our Sudbury partnership conversations.

At our gathering in March, we had opportunity to explore transitions, and how transitions are impacting our individual and area United Church communities of Faith. Attendees of the gathering overwhelmingly spoke in favour of gathering again to consider areas of mutual cooperation, such as child and youth ministries, worship partnerships, and shared technologies.
