Au Pair - What does it mean?

An au pair is a young single female between the ages of 20-26 who lives with a family in a country other than her own for a maximum of 12 months, helps with general housework and childcare in exchange for room, board and pocket money (stipend). The Au Pair program is a cultural exchange and the au pair is given the opportunity to learn about and to experience the culture of the country that she is in. In return, the Au Pair will be asked to perform general household duties (washing and tidying up, laundry, ironing, cooking etc.) and to take care of children during a limited number of hours a day and/or baby-sit at night. The Au Pair is not an employee but a member of the family and will be treated as such.

Au Pair requirements

- Are you between 20 to 26 years old? (must arrive prior to 27th birthday)
- Are you in good health?
 Have a minimum of 500 hours of childcare experience with non-related parties (No family)
- OR have a driver's license and have at least 250 hours of childcare experience with children under the age of 2 years old?
- Have you completed your secondary school education?
- Speak English with a rating of GOOD to Excellent? (B1 and above)
- Have a clean criminal record? (clean criminal record submitted)
- Can you commit to 12 months living with an American family? (OR stay up to two years)
