- As of May 15, 2022 Sarcan will now be accepting household glass. Types of Containers accepted are food jars, food bottles, baby juice bottles, canning jars and glass storage containers. Make sure your containers are as clean as possible and caps are removed.
- > Reminder to residents to have garbage cans in the alley. Garbage will be not be picked up if smaller garbage bags are used min 26in x 30in, and will also not be picked if they are not tied when full. If there are small shopping bags, these need to be put into larger bags and tied when ready.

 PLEASE SURE THAT ALL GARBAGE BAGS ARE TIED TIGHTLY
- Asking residents to use clear bags for leaves and grass clippings. Leaves/clippings ect. will not be picked up if they are not in clear bags.
- When having open air fires, please remember to take all safety precautions. Have a proper fire pit and please burn clean wood. Your fire pit should be located a minimum of 10ft from any combustible material and not located on a combustible surface. All fires should be supervised by an adult. Check the weather as well. It should be non-windy conditions. You should be prepared during the fire making sure that you have proper means of extinguishing fires (garden hose should be present and ready to use). Any smoke interfering with the use and enjoyment of another person's property should be extinguished. Please keep our Town safe!!!

- CONTROLLED BURNS Sometimes you will need to burn grass, bush piles or stubble. Please be sure you are well prepared and that you have fire guards in place. These "controlled burns" should also be reported to avoid dispatching firefighters unnecessarily. TO REPORT A CONTROLLED BURN, PLEASE CALL 1—866-404-4911. Please have your land location, what your RM is, who your fire service provider, location details is, what are you burning, how long the burn will last and your name and phone number. You will be asked to call back once the burn is completed.
- It shall be lawful to operate a Golf Cart during the hours between one-half hour prior to sunrise and one-half hour after sunset on all public highways within the limits of the Town of Ponteix with the exception of Centre Street, strictly for the purposes of travelling by the most direct route between the golf course and the storage location of the golf cart. Golf carts may only access Centre Street for the purpose of direct crossing. No one shall operate a golf cart within the Town of Ponteix unless they hold a valid class 7 driver's licence or higher. The owner of the Golf Cart must insure themselves and every other person who, with the owner's consent, operates that golf cart, against liability imposed by law arising out the ownership, use or operation of that golf cart and provides proof of insurance at the request of a peace officer.
