She was inspired by John McCrae’s poem “In Flanders Fields”. Anna had originally founded a charity to help rebuild regions of France torn apart by the First World War, and created poppies made of fabric to raise funds. Later, Anna presented her concept to France’s allies, including the precursor to the, The Great War Veterans Association. The idea was considered at a meeting in Port Arthur, Ontario (now Thunder Bay) and was adopted on July 6, 1921. For the last 100 years the Poppy is worn each year during the Remembrance period to honour Canada’s Fallen. Please help support our Veterans and give to the Poppy Fund.**
