## **7 SIMPLE STEPS**

# TO MAKE YOUR EVENT A SUCCESS!



### STEP 1

#### **PLAN YOUR EVENT**

Let the brainstorming begin. Choose something based on your interest and your guests. Set your fundraising goals. Do not overextend yourself — you want to have fun too! Determine if you need a committee or volunteers to help.

### STEP 2

# SET A DATE, TIME, VENUE AND BUDGET FOR YOUR EVENT

Be mindful of holidays and other events taking place. List your sources of income from ticket sales, sponsorships, donations, etc. and list your expenses such as costs for venue, decorations, food and entertainment.

### STEP 3

# REGISTER YOUR EVENT WITH HILL HOUSE

Our team will help you get started. You'll get access to brochures and online tools including a custom fundraising page to help manage your event. Plus you'll get access to our Community Event Logo to use on your marketing material. Any printed or digital material using the logo must be pre-approved by Hill House Hospice.

### STEP 4

# ANNOUNCE AND PROMOTE YOUR EVENT

Send out invitations by mail or email. Post the event to your social media accounts. Tag us at #hillhousehospice. Tell us about it! If suitable, your event can be shared to our social media accounts. The event organizer must inform everyone involved that Hill House Hospice is only the beneficiary of the event and that we are not organizing the event. Furthermore, Hill House Hospice will not assume any liability – legal, financial, or otherwise – for the event nor accept any responsibility for damages or injuries due to the event.

### STEP 5

# ENJOY YOUR EVENT AND COLLECT FUNDS

Share photos on social media and enjoy your event. Use the online tools to collect donations or collect the donor's full name and mailing address so that Hill House Hospice can issue each person a charitable tax receipt. Cheques should be made payable to Hill House Hospice.

### STEP 6

### SUBMIT THE FUNDS RAISED

Submit your funds raised to Hill House within 30 days. Contact us at 905-737-9308 to drop the funds (cash/cheques) off in person or submit funds by mail, electronic funds transfer or over the phone for credit card payments.

### STEP 7

# THANK EVERYONE INVOLVED IN YOUR EVENT

Send a thank you card or email to the attendees, participants, donors and sponsors to show your appreciation. If you are considering a repeat event, let everyone know to "save the date!"
