POSITION SUMMARY:

Student Ambassador Volunteers are under 18 years old and help raise awareness of Hill House Hospice throughout York Region. Volunteers serve as advocates for the organization by supporting outreach activities, educational events and community initiatives such as fairs, festivals and markets, and support the Walk for Hill House Hospice.

RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Representing Hill House Hospice at community events
- Assisting with information tables and outreach activities
- Supporting third-party fundraising events
- Delivering promotional materials
- Helping with office or administrative special projects
- Assisting with seasonal campaigns or mailings
- Sharing information about hospice programs and services
- Supporting donor and community engagement activities

QUALIFICATIONS VOLUNTEERS SHOULD HAVE:

- Be personable, organized and dependable
- Have strong communication skills
- Feel comfortable engaging with community members
- Be passionate about supporting hospice care
- Enjoy working independently and collaboratively

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Flexible scheduling with opportunities available weekdays, evenings and weekends
- Minimum of 1 shift per month for minimum of a one year commitment
- 7 hours mandatory training required (3 hours for hospice education, 1 hour orientation and 3 hours for shadow shift)
- Ideal for students under 18 years
