What is Wildflowers?:

The wildflower homeschool co-op is a place for families who have autistic children who can help their children bloom! This co-op is for families who are homeschooling their autistic children and want a community that will support you, encourage you, share resources, & understand the journey of autism. To then create a community for families where we can help one another bloom where we are planted! This co-op is NOT a drop off co-op. Each child will have to be accompanied by an adult during all meet-up times. This co-op is run by pockets of peace non-profit organization that is a 501(c)3 that is dedicated to serving & supporting the families with autistic children.

Who is it for?:

Wildflowers is for families of autistic children who are homeschooling and want support. All levels of autism are welcome, and all ages. Your child and family are wanted here and we can't wait to serve you!

Enrollment?:

In the state of South Carolina by the age of 6 your child needs to be legally enrolled in school. If you choose to homeschool your child does need to legally be enrolled. In wildflowers we will help you get your child all set up so you do not have any extra stress. We have a separate handout that walks through step by step how to enroll your child with the state, stress free! Once you are registered with the state you are required to keep your own home school records on file. As for enrollment in the wild flowers co-op we just ask you sign up with how many people will be attending so we can plan accordingly.

What is the cost?:

FREE! As a fellow autism mom I understand how much money parents of special needs children spend on therapies, doctors appointments, and daily life. We do not want this to be an added burden but something to help you and your family bloom free of charge. The only cost would be to legally enroll your child with the state of SC for homeschool annually.

This co-op is located in upstate, Simpsonville South Carolina. Meet ups will be in Simpsonville SC, we will also do field trips all over Greenville.
