Town Council Meeting Minutes

Monday, August 17th, 2026, 7:00 p.m.

July 2026, minutes:

July 2026 meeting minutes were presented for approval. President Andy Swain made a motion to approve the July 2026 minutes. Council Member Bill Barber seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Claims:

July 2026 claim vouchers Nos. 50 – 56 were presented for review. President Andy Swain made a motion to approve payment of the claims. Council Member Bill Barber seconded the motion. Motion carried.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

Street Commissioner – Wally Althaus – Crim & Sons completed paving. Nice job.

Planning Commission – Byron Holden – Not in attendance.

BZA – Sandy Casey – Not in attendance.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. New benches and playground equipment. Wally Althaus continues obtaining quotes for new benches and playground. ESW approved of \$4250.00 approved. ESW applied new mulch – playground looks nice.
2. Bridge painting – Tristian Bundy referred painter to Town – Brian, sending quote via email. Diana to reach out to VFenney for a quote.
3. Flagpole / CB lighting updates – project incorporated in CB enhancements.
4. Substitutes candidates for BZA & Planning Commission. – Paul Grunner expressed interest in serving BZA alternate and will attend a meeting to gain a better understanding. Andy to follow up with Mr. Grunner.
5. Tree Removal - Estimate received for removal of poplar and shagbark hickory trees, including stump grinding and work near the inlet. Wally to follow up with Holmes Tree Care for timeline. Current weather is causing delays in timeline.
6. 2027 Budget – Discussion regarding the September/October budget process.
7. CAP Response – Discussion/action regarding the SBOA Corrective Action Plan (CAP) response. The previous CAP was updated to meet SBOA requirements. Andy Swain made motion to approve the updated CAP. Bill Barber and David Johnson voted in favor. Motion carried. Council adopted, signed the updated corrective action plan.
8. CB enhancements – Andy met with McIntire landscaping out of Shelbyville. Will provide landscaping quotes.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Aerators back up and running. Hoosier Aquatic Care identified blown capacitors. Andy made motion to approve Invoice 248927 in the amount of \$219.00, payable to HAC for repairs. Bill seconded the motion. Motion carried.
2. CAPS – One additional Resolution required for SBOA. Resolution adopting SBOA uniform internal control standards for Indiana political subdivisions. Diana Johnson presented resolution 2026-3. Andy Swain read to council, Andy made motion to approve and adopt resolution 2026-3. Bill Barber seconded The motion. Motion carried. Resolution 2026-3 was signed by the Council.
