Throughout the last year and a half, so many things have changed in each of our lives and we have decided to focus on one fundraising event per year, Diesel Jam, returning in June 2022 at the Circle Drive-In and our Truck-or-Treat community event on October 23, 2021.

At this year's Picnic & Raffle a delicious hot buffet will be provided by Morrison's Catering. In addition to the buffet, there will also be basket raffles, gift card raffles, high ticket item raffles, a 50/50 raffle, Spool in Peace and Diesel Jam apparel and merchandise, a beverage tent (additional \$10 with Valid ID), live entertainment (featuring Dead Nutz), activities, & more! Please note that basket raffle entries will end at 3pm, so if you are coming for the raffles, be sure to arrive before then!

Tickets for the event are a \$20 donation and include the buffet & soda, however they are not required for entry if you are coming for the raffles and fun! Mazza Memorial Health Center still remains fully operational and has expanded since it opened! We are looking forward to bringing back our community Truck-or-Treat event, which we invite you to attend on October 23rd at the Clifford Municipal Building. Truck-or-Treat is free of charge and features a spooky (kid-friendly) Halloween Theme set-up where kids can gather candy and other goodies provided by The Andrew Mazza Foundation and other local businesses and families! At the 2019 event, we had over 500 attendees in just a few hours and are looking forward to making this a great Halloween for local families again! It is our privilege to be able to host an event that gives back to the community that has given us so much.

Through your generosity and support, we have been able to continue to provide high school students at Lakeland, Carbondale Area, Forest City, and Mountain View scholarship funding, including a scholarship through the American Legion.

Although we were unable to host any events in 2020, we were able to continue to provide donations to families within our community who suffered a tragic loss or hardship and make donations to other area local non-profits organizations, including an annual Christmas toy drive and veterans organizations. None of those accomplishments would be possible without the support we have received from you, our community, and we can not show our gratitude enough.
