We don't have the same danger from ticks, but we do have poisonous snakes and the odd forgotten land-mine. So, please pray for safety as well as spiritual activities.

Praise:

- Making good connections with our English students.
- The two interns we have are doing great!
- Great presentation from our interns with the Hands of Honor girls

Prayer:

- Experience God night connections; we have 5 that are coming to Bible Storying and are hearing the parables of Jesus this semester. One of the interns is now presenting the stories; pray for her as she does this. Pray for open hearts and understanding
- Trauma and healing class just for women with Krista and one of our interns; it is going well; three women, good conversations; pray for deeper talks and spiritual understanding and openness

Spronk, Dr. Wayne & Suzanne, Bongolo Hospital, Gabon

- Praise God that we found an excellent renter who already signed on for the next 20 months that we plan to be gone.
- Praise God for our daughter's good experience on a shortterm mission trip to Cambodia. God is speaking to her. Pray for the whole trip to end well and for her to retain the lessons she is learning.
- Pray for our upcoming speaking engagements, that we will connect well with people and represent God's work well.
- Pray for the plans, dreams and direction of starting a new training program for primary care. It is not off the ground yet. Pray for God's will to be clear in how to move forward.

Valach, Dr. Renee, Bongolo Hospital, Gabon

- Pray for Gabon. Last month I mentioned that we received HIV medicines. Unfortunately, there weren't very many, and now they are all gone. Now we really don't have any. It breaks, my heart, for the patients who were doing well, and now we don't have any medicines to give.
- Gabon is also now out of TB medicines until September. The last time the country was out, it was for over a year. I'm thankful this time it will only be for several months. I'm also thankful that we have enough to complete the treatment for all of our patients who have already started the 6-month treatment. We don't have

- enough medicine to begin the treatment for new patients, and we already have a waiting list. Some of the patients, unfortunately may not make it to September.
- Pray for me as I'm getting ready to go on a one-year Home Assignment. My other Home Assignments have always been 3 to 4 months. Since I've been away from Bongolo for relatively short times, I've tried to cover some things from the US. This time, I will be gone for a whole year. I will be handing over all my responsibilities at the hospital, and moving out of my house, so someone else could live there. There is much more to do to prepare.

Zogg, Ed & Sandy, Dominican Republic

- We are still in the process of moving into our house and the Lord has blessed us with couches, and all kinds of furniture and kitchen stuff. We found a washer and dryer on FB marketplace for \$235! We are still looking for a bedroom set with a queen bed and a freezer. The district is loaning us a car to use for ministry. God is so good!
- we are making good progress on the land in the DR. We have begun construction on the children's center. The cistern is complete. We have dug out for the perimeter wall and have backfilled a good portion of the land so we can start using it. We are doing a VBS starting Friday on the land! Please pray that many kids come to know Jesus.
