Our previous church had a little library area which is full of donated books. I was browsing through them one day when I came across The Jaffrey Series which is a series of biographies written about the lives of different Alliance International Workers. I had read a couple of these at one time or another, so I was happy to see the entire series.

It was encouraging to read how God used each one, even though they were all gifted in different ways. Some had the gifts of teaching, others helps, still others administration. But a common thread ran through all their lives. They each had a desire for people to know the love and saving power of Jesus Christ. And because of that desire, they were willing to endure terrible hardship and at times, persecution, and separation from family.

Romans 10:12-15 says, "For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

These verses are our commission to reach our neighborhoods, communities and the world for Christ. I fear that the American church has gotten quite complacent about that commission. Our biggest concern is for our own convenience and comfort, and we don't want anything to interfere with what we hold near and dear.
