

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUATION OF
SALES TAX ON UTILITIES FOR DOMESTIC USE

Ordinance No. 102

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of St. Elizabeth, Missouri, as follows:

Pursuant to Section 2 of Senate Bills Nos. 218, 235, 298, 340 and 398, Laws of 80th General Assembly, First Regular Session, the city sales tax at the rate of one percent shall continue to be imposed from and after January 1, 1980, upon all sales of metered water services, electricity, electrical current and natural, artificial or propane gas, wood, coal, or home heating oil for domestic use within the Village of St. Elizabeth, Miller County, Missouri.

Publicly read and passed by majority vote of the Board of Trustees at a regular meeting this 29th day of October, 1979.
