

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE BID OF MARKWAY EXCAVATING FOR THE PUMP HOUSE AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE WITH THE SAID FIRM COVERING THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELIZABETH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid of Markway Excavating, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101, on Section IV EDA Project No. 06-1-00592 of the Plans and Specifications of Groner & Picker, Inc., engineer for the construction of elevated tank, well, pumphouse and distribution for the waterworks of the Village, and for the furnishing and installation of pump house as provided for in said Plans and Specifications, is also hereby accepted and approved, subject to approval of Farmers Home Administration.

Section 2. The Chairman of the Board of Trustees of St. Elizabeth, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with said firm on behalf of said Village binding and obligating the Village to pay to the Contractor said Contractor's bid price for the work and materials covered by the aforesaid Sections of said Plans and Specifications upon completion thereof in accordance with said Plans and Specifications, or as otherwise provided in said Plans and Specifications and approved by said Groner & Picker, Inc., engineer.
