AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE NEGOTIATED BID OF MARKWAY EXCAVATION FOR THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE WITH THE SAID FIRM COVERING THE CONSTRUCT-ION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELIZABETH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The negotiated bid of Markway Execavation, Jefferson City, Missouri, on Section 2 of the Plans and Specifications of Groner & Picker, Inc., engineer for the construction of distribution system, elevated tank, well, and pumphouse for the waterworks of the Village, and for the furnishing and installation of the distribution system as provided for in said Plans and Specification, is also hereby accepted and approved, subject to approval of Farmers Home Administration.

Section 2. The Chairman of the Board of Trustees of St. Elizabeth, Missouri, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with said firm on behalf of said Village binding and obligating the Village to pay to the Contractor said Contractor's bid price for the work and materials covered by the aforesaid Sections of said Plans and Specifications upon completion thereof in accordance with said Plans and Specifications, or as otherwise provided in said Plans and Specification and approved by said Groner & Picker, Inc., engineer.
