

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELIZABETH, MISSOURI, ON MAY 23, 1967, AT WHICH ELECTION THERE WAS SUBMITTED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID VILLAGE THE FOLLOWING PROPOSITION: PROPOSITION TO ISSUE THE WATERWORKS REVENUE BONDS OF THE VILLAGE TO THE AMOUNT OF \$110,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING A PORTION OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING WATERWORKS TO BE OWNED EXCLUSIVELY BY SAID VILLAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEE OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELIZABETH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that the vote at the special election held in the Village of St. Elizabeth, Missouri, on May 23, 1967, for the purpose of paying a portion of the cost of constructing waterworks to be owned exclusively by said Village, resulted as follows:

PROPOSITION - \$110,000.00 WATERWORKS REVENUE BONDS:

Section 2. That it is hereby found, declared and determined that more than four sevenths of the qualified voters of the Village of St. Elizabeth, Missouri, voting at said election voted in favor of issuing the waterworks revenue bonds of said Village to the amount of \$110,000.00 and said proposition to authorize the issuance of said bonds is hereby found and declared to have carried by a vote of 75 ballots for said waterworks revenue bonds and 10 ballots against the issuance of said waterworks revenue bonds, and that the governing body of said Village is therefore vested with full power and authority to issue bonds for said purpose, as provided by law.

Section 3. That it is further found, declared and determined that notice of said election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law, and that said election was duly given and published in the manner provided by law, and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity

with the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri covering elections in villages.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
