

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE CERTAIN ALLEYS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. ELIZABETH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

The Board finds and determines that certain alleys or parts of alleys as shown on the original plat of the Town of Charlestown (now St. Elizabeth), are no longer in use, are no longer needed, and should be vacated in the interests of the orderly development of the town.

1. As to the alley running north and south between Lots 6 and 7 and between Lots 2 and 3 of Block 2 (which alley runs between Main and Plum streets), the southernmost 225 feet is hereby vacated, leaving the northern 87 feet of alley opening onto Plum Street in public use.


2. As to the alley running east and west between Lots 4 and 5, 3 and 6, 2 and 7, and 1 and 8 of Block 2 (which alley runs between Walnut and Franklin streets), the easternmost 225 feet is hereby vacated, leaving the western 67 feet of alley opening onto Walnut Street in public use.

3. As to the alley running north and south between Lots 6 and 7 and between Lots 2 and 3 of Block 6 (which alley runs between Main and Church streets), the entire alley is vacated.
